4 | Authorization, Assumption of Risk & Informed Consent

By signing this document, I agree that I understand and accept the risks associated with the Neighbourhood Play Program for my child as his or her parent or legal guardian. In consideration of permission granted now or in the future by the YWCA Lethbridge and District to participate in the Neighbourhood Play Program (NPP), which may include physical activity and sport related events, including playing on playground equipment between July , 2025 and August 14, 2025, I agree, authorize and acknowledge the following:

1. My child described in Section 1 has met all of the prerequisites to participate in the NPP.
2. My child will abide by the rules imposed on the participants in the NPP.
3. Pick-up & drop-off times (these times apply to all regular site days)

- Neighbourhood Play Program begins at 8:30am each day, Monday to Thursday. The YWCA cannot guarantee supervision of your child before this time.
- Site supervision ends at 3:30pm. Children **MUST** be picked up promptly at this time. In the event that a parent or guardian has not picked up their child within a reasonable amount of time, and if alternative arrangements have not been communicated to the leaders, we will call the emergency contact provided on your registration form. We cannot guarantee supervision of your child after 3:30.
- In the event of a weather warning, the YWCA may require children to be picked-up or dropped-off at an alternative time. We will contact you by phone if this is the case.
- **In the event that any child remains at site as of 4:30pm, without prior arrangements being made with the leaders, the YWCA reserves the right to contact Child Protective Services.**

Authorized pickup

- Please alert the leaders in the event that anyone who is not listed on the intake form will be picking up your child.
- We suggest developing a “code word” that is known to your child and any authorized persons who may be picking them up.

Items to bring

Neighbourhood Play Program is an outdoor play group. Clothing should be suitable for running, jumping and getting dirty! Please ensure that your child has the following each day:

- Water bottle
- Snack(s)
- Sunscreen &/or bug spray
- Closed-toe shoes
- Hat
- Weather appropriate clothing

Daily Consent to Walk Home Unsupervised Form

NPP participants are only permitted to leave site when a designated individual picks them up, unless written consent is given for them to walk home unsupervised. By signing this form, you acknowledge all risks associated with permitting your child to walk home from site without the supervision of another individual and release the YWCA Lethbridge & District from all liability associated with these risks.

Please note that participants are **only** allowed to walk home at the end of program at 3:30 PM Monday to Thursday. **Additional written or verbal consent *given directly to a leader* is required if your child will be leaving site at a time other than those listed.**
